

Set up in the office or school car park and earn some shiny pounds for every car you clean!


Gaming for good

Want to make your money go further with Gift Aid?

- Gift Aid is a scheme that allows charities to reclaim tax on a donation made by a UK taxpayer.
- If you Gift Aid your donations, we can claim back 25p for every £1 you donate to The Little Princess Trust.
