## The best ways to collect money from your Funky Hair Funday

#### Online donation services

Starting a page dedicated to your Funky Hair Funday on a site such as JustGiving is an easy way for those taking part to add to your fundraising total.

#### Sponsorship form

You can also collect money by asking all involved in your Funky Hair Funday to use the sponsorship form provided to make a donation.

#### Getting your fundraising to us

Sites such as JustGiving send the money pledged directly to us. As for cash donations, count them with a friend before banking them. You can then send the amount raised to us by:

- Calling us on **01432 352359** to pay by phone.
- Visiting the Donate Money page on our website to pay online.
- Making a cheque payable to The Little Princess Trust and sending it to the address in our sponsor form.

#### Make your money go further with Gift Aid

Gift Aid is a scheme that allows charities to reclaim tax on a donation made by a UK taxpayer.

If you Gift Aid your donations, we can claim back 25p for every £1 you donate to The Little Princess Trust.



This additional income makes a huge difference to us and the young people we support. Sites such as JustGiving simplify the Gift Aid process while we can also claim this vital extra income if people tick the 'Gift Aid It' box on the sponsorship form and answer each question.
